Sunset Manuel Antonio Restaurant & Bar

his charming spot opened its doors in the heart of Manuel Antonio, under the management of Jose Badilla in 2024. Jose's originally from Alajuela, but he's been living in Quepos for over 25 years.

His love for cooking and food began when he was a child and his family opened a restaurant in their home. By 2008, he was hired as head chef at one of Manuel Antonio's most famous restaurants. Here, in addition to further developing his artistry in the kitchen, he developed his dream of owning a place with affordable food and drinks.

Sunset's menu features a wide variety of dishes, but the Chifrijo (a local dish of tender beans, rice, pico de gallo, and pork chicharrón) is one of their most popular dishes. Their cuts of meat, cooked to

order, are also in high demand. Traditional cocktails, national and international beers, desserts, and Costa Rican coffee are also on the menu.

The restaurant has two floors. The first floor features a bar, tables, chairs, a pool table, foosball, darts, and screens showing all kinds of sports. The second is an open terrace with an ocean view, a bar, tables, and chairs. There is private parking for the restaurant.

Sunset is open 7 days a week from 12 noon to 10 pm with Happy Hour from 4 pm to 6 pm. On Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, there is music from 4 pm to 6 pm with DJs and live music from 6 pm to 8 pm.

Soy Extranjero

ome of you may be aware Kelly and I were opposed to a project that was going to be built in the area. We weren't the only ones. A few weeks ago someone reminded me of this on facebook. I received a few private messages from her. She told me that I was a foreigner, extranjero. Later she told me I should go back to where I came from. We heard this often.

Sometimes they used ring lights as they cried about the mean foreigner on facebook.

They used the word to tell me I should not speak up. I should shut up. Since I wasn't born here, my opinions are lesser. This kind of nationalism is ugly. It is one reason I left the United States. My family has heard it for generations.

The German Empire evicted my great great grandfather and his parents in the 1850s for being Jewish. Authorities seized their home, their possessions, and their business. They loaded them into a boat and sent them to the United States. That's probably the first time we heard that we didn't belong somewhere. My great great grandfather fought for the North in the Civil War. Despite this he was still told he didn't

belong, sometimes the message was bloody. In 1895 all of his wife's brothers and brothers in law were murdered on the Shark River in New Jersey. The police declared it a fishing accident despite the bodies being covered by bruises. They didn't belong there.

His grandson, my grandfather, was refused lodging at every bed and breakfast in Vermont for his honeymoon because he looked Jewish. He was told he didn't belong there.

My parents moved to Wisconsin from New Jersey a few months before I was born. I grew up hearing that I wasn't from the area, even though I was born there. 51 years after they moved people tell us we aren't from there. I grew up hearing that I didn't belong there and should go back to where I came from.

No matter where I've lived I have heard that I am not from the area. People use this thinking it will silence me. I don't write this for sympathy. I am writing this so that people understand, it won't shut me up. It helps me understand I have found my new home.

I come from a long line of people that heard this. We are going on 175 years of hearing this crap. Nothing will drive my roots deeper than hearing I don't belong somewhere. Most importantly, your populist words say far more about you and your soul than they say about me. I grew up in a town of xenophobes. It is weird they don't use the same words for the owner of project and the investors.

My only question for them is, "Exactly how long does someone need to live and pay taxes somewhere before they get a voice?"





Maik & Loops

ichael Muñoz, who has an extensive musical career, began experimenting with *loops* in 2011. *Loops* are a way to capture musical repetitions and create electronic music with acoustic instruments and sounds of nature, resulting in a very particular musical texture.

Michael noticed that you tend to hear the same music repeated over and over, everywhere. This gave rise to the innovative idea of creating a unique atmosphere in the moment. The music isn't repeated; it's created for the moment, according to the people, the event and the location.

As part of this inspiration, a project was undertaken in 2014 in Manuel Antonio National Park, where for months they recorded sounds of nature: animals, insects, wind and waves etc. From the richness of these tracks, along with eight musicians, they released an album called "Manuel Antonio Vivo". The album was debuted at Marina Pez Vela at the end of 2018. There were plans for a tour, but the pandemic hit and the project had to be put on hold. The plan is to re-release the album in 2026 and the tour in 2027.

Michael and his parner, Mariel Lopez, currently run *Vida Pura Producciones*, an event production company specializing in video, graphic design, and photography.





enjoy the food, the companionship and live music for a Tico Tropical Christmas!


Celebrate "El Año Nuevo" with us on December 31st
